Steps to Host a FAFSA Completion Event



- 1. Schedule a time (Oct-Dec) when parents & students can meet together for an FAFSA completion event (it might need to be held outside of school hours). Some communities might also choose to do a 2nd FAFSA event Jan-Feb
- 2. Contact financial aid representative from a local community college, technical college, or university to help present information and answer questions for parents during the event.

- 3. Prepare Students for the Event
 - Provide a lesson about the FAFSA & types of financial aid <u>FAFSA Introduction Video</u> <u>Financial Aid/FAFSA resource document</u>
 - Take students through creating their FSA ID prior to the event **FSA ID Instructional video**
 - Send the **FAFSA** on the Web Worksheet or **FAFSA** Completion Checklist home to complete prior to the event. (This will help families know what information is needed and what questions they have for FAFSA completion day)
