## **Notes**

Specifics pertaining to the Corrections Program:

- 1. An agreed upon third party nationally recognized credential does not exist for correctional officers.
- 2. The Kansas Department of Corrections has endorsed the common courses and requested that colleges offer the designated exit point in addition to the A.A.S. credential.

## **Community Corrections CIP 43.0199**

- Colleges with programs preparing students for positions as parole officers or in other community-based corrections professions will utilize 43.0199 to identify their program for reporting purposes on the state data system.
- Institutions with Police Science and Criminal Justice programs are "encouraged" to evaluate the identified common courses for potential inclusion in their programs.
