Specifics pertaining to the Corrections Program:

- An agreed upon third party nationally recognized credential does not exist for correctional officers.
- The Kansas Department of Corrections has endorsed the common courses and requested that colleges offer the designated exit point in addition to the AAS credential.

Community Corrections CIP 43.0199

Colleges with programs preparing students for positions as parole officers or in other community-based corrections professions will utilize 43.0199 to identify their program for reporting purposes on the state data system.

Institutions with Police Science and Criminal Justice programs are "encouraged" to evaluate the identified common courses for potential inclusion in their programs.
