Kansas Computer Science Educator Scholarship Program

The Computer Science Educator Scholarship provides a one-time \$1,000 award for licensed K-12 teachers enrolled in college courses for additional college credit, or preservice K-12 teachers enrolled in college courses leading to licensure as a teacher. **Recipients must be a Kansas resident. Recipients must be enrolled in a computer science course during the semester they are applying for this scholarship and must be attending a postsecondary educational institution in the state of Kansas** (includes state institutions, community colleges, or not-for-profit institutions). Approved computer science courses include those that focus on curriculum and instruction strategies for teaching computer science courses. Also included are courses that study computers and algorithmic processes, including principles, hardware and software designs, implementation, and impact on society. Priority consideration is given to individuals who are from underrepresented socioeconomic demographic groups, or those who plan to teach computer science in a rural school or a school with a higher percentage of students from underrepresented socioeconomic demographics. Though it is not required, for priority consideration applicants must be able to file a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
